




THE SCENE

In the unspoilt north-east corner of the beautiful island of Zakynthos, Greece, a stylish party is permanently on the go. Overlooking the sea, where paddleboarders. dinghy sailors and waterskiers learn their skills, the fashionably dressed lounge on day beds drinking rosé. It's like being in a SS17 Front Row-but wearing Havaianas instead of heels. Welcome to The Peligoni Club.



The low-key clubhouse, with its spa, bar, restaurant, tennis courts. backgammon under the trees and watersports, is the hub for 48 luxury villas (and three B&Bs). These are scattered over the surrounding hills, so you can be as social (or anti-social) as you like. Ours, Villa Figari, is the showpiece. Built from honey-coloured stone. with blue shutters and nine bedrooms, it's perfect for a house party, with shady terraces for lounging. aswimming pool, and a private jetty fordivinginto the cool blue sea.



HOT HOTELS

THEVIBE

Chic but chilled, this is not for the Ibiza party crowd or the Tulum fashion set, but a slick, smoothly run, smallscale luxury escape with an airy and open atmosphere. The charming service, with everything orderable on an iPad, can be a touch haphazard, but you can overlook that with a location this good. Peligoni is a big draw for families, but outside school holidays it ticks all the boxes for couples and child-free groups, too.

THE FOOD

Villa Figari is just a few minutes' walk from the clubhouse, where lunch and dinner (Greek salads, freshly made pizzas and simple grills) are a laidback, taverna-style affair. A five-minute drive takes you to the port of Agios Nikolaos, for restaurants so close to the water you can feed the fish from your table. For a more St Tropez vibe, and probably the best G&T on the island. Nobelos restaurant (nobelos.gr) is superb.



INTHEHOOD

Don't miss the boat ride to the Blue Caves, and shipwrecks on the spectacular Navagio beach. For sporty guests, the 30-minute sea swim along the coastline from Figari should be on life's must-do list. Book a trip on the elegant sailboat, where you get to see the best of the island, eat lunch on the wave while lying offshore and, if you're lucky, spot loggerhead turtles.
